Summary of Job: The Infant and Toddler Teacher plan and implement an ongoing program of activities that promote the social, emotional, cognitive and physical development of each child.

Essential Job Functions:

- Planning, implementing and evaluation child development experience, routines, interests and relaying needed information to the parents
- Supervise and monitor children's indoor and outdoor activities
- Must have the ability to walk, stand and sit (including on the floor) for extended periods.
- Reading, singing, playing with children
- Must be able to lift and/or assist children up to 50 pounds in weight
- Plan daily classroom activities and routines
- Protect safety and health of children closely following classroom rules and procedures
- Supervise children by continually remaining within sight and sound
- Feed infants' solid foods as age-appropriate and provided by parents
- Change diapers as needed
- Set up food, snacks, assist children and cleans up after snacks
- Ensure play, sleep and changing areas are kept clean
- Maintains confidentiality
- Maintains a safe and healthy environment
- Perform other duties as assigned
